The Overall Outcomes of the Monitoring Visit

- The TUV Nord Training Centre has taken positive actions to sufficiently address four of the recommendations, particularly by enhancing training methodologies and assessment standards. These efforts have resulted in increased learners' engagement and improved skills development and knowledge acquisition. However, the remaining two recommendations show partial improvement only.
- There is significant potential for further improvement in record-keeping, as well as in the aggregation and analysis of learners' performance, which would better support decision-making. Additionally, although the Centre has recently finalised its updated quality assurance manual, the full impact of its implementation on the overall quality of provision has yet to be realised.
- The Centre will be scheduled for a review as per BQA's policies and procedures.
