Review Summary

- The school's leadership shows effective supervision of its strategic planning based on important priorities, and strong partnerships. Its commitment to teachers' training contributes to improved teaching practices.
- Effective strategies are implemented in most lessons, particularly in science and mathematics, mostly in the Scientific Stream, leading to good academic outcomes for students.
- The school should prioritise improving students' English language skills, especially in the Literary Stream.
- The impact of teachers' training programmes requires further monitoring and evaluation, particularly in the Literary and Commercial Streams. Additionally, the school should focus more on optimising learning time, challenging students, and providing targeted support for low achievers.
- The school was graded as Good when reviewed and it will draft an Action Plan based on the review recommendations.
