**Compliant with the General Framework Standards**

### Main Finding

The University is committed to promoting excellence in applied education and research and contributing to sustainable community growth and development. During the review, the following practices were identified as areas of strength: the substantive involvement of student representatives in the affairs of the University through different councils, committees and panels; the significant efforts exerted by the University to ensure that its programmes cope with rapid technological advances to enhance the employability of its graduates; the well-established alumni platform that allows data collection and regular track and updates; and the strong sense of social responsibility which is evinced in a variety of activities to support the local community, involving its internal and external stakeholders.

As per the review recommendations, the University is asked to reduce the faculty's teaching load, considering the supervision of multiple master's theses and their other academic and administrative duties to maintain high teaching quality; revisit the policies related to handling legal issues concerning academic and non-academic staff and increasing their retention rates; enhance the library's physical and digital resources, ensuring sufficient coverage across all programme disciplines; and develop mechanisms to ensure that admission criteria for each programme are regularly reviewed to ensure alignment with international standards.
