- The French School of Bahrain is a Good school with Outstanding features.
- The leadership team shows a clear awareness of improvement priorities and has developed a strong strategic plan to drive positive change.
- Students' attainment in external examinations is impressive and their multilingual abilities enable them to integrate seamlessly into the school.
- Students exhibit exemplary behaviour, which is fostered in a welcoming and inclusive environment that puts students personal support at its heart.
- Teaching is good in most lessons, with continuous challenge and support positively impacting most students' progress.
- In some less effective lessons, the progress of low achieving students is hindered by inconsistent differentiation and feedback.
- There is a need for more targeted professional development programmes for teachers, with careful monitoring of the impact on their performance.
- Arabic language skills require further attention across the school.
- The school is Good when reviewed and will draft an Action Plan based on the review recommendations.
