Main Finding

Bahrain Polytechnic (BP) offers applied, industry-focused programmes in engineering, business, information and communication technology, and design, focusing on practical learning, problem-solving, and employability. During the review the following practices were identified as areas of strength: BP's unique vision and mission and values which have given the institution an exceptional standing within the higher education environment in Kingdom of Bahrain; the institution-wide staff performance management system and approach to identifying staff development needs and offering appropriate training and professional development opportunities; the close collaboration with industry and their intensive involvement in the curriculum review process; and the holistic approach in effectively cultivating a learning environment that supports lifelong learning and equal opportunities through structured programmes, continuous evaluation, diverse extracurricular activities, and active student involvement.

As per the review recommendations, BP should develop comprehensive annual operational plans for all academic and administrative departments, ensure research and scholarly activities positively impact learning and teaching and community engagement activities with its vision, mission and strategic plan. Additionally, BP is encouraged to enhance its physical infrastructure based on stakeholders' feedback and develop comprehensive recruitment plans to support its rapid expansion, especially regarding student admissions and postgraduate programmes.
