Main Finding

The Royal University for Women (RUW) is committed to maintaining its unique identity as a university dedicated to women, focusing on developing confident female leaders. During the review, the following practices were identified as areas of strength: the institution's dedication to continuous professional development by providing MOOCs subscriptions to all academic and administrative staff, the thorough and rigorous feasibility studies conducted to develop and update academic programmes, the establishment of the RUW Women's Research Centre as a hub for forming research communities alongside the university's regular research forum activities, and RUW's significant local and international partnerships that enhance its global presence and enable students to participate in both international and local events.

As per the review recommendations, the University is asked to enhance and implement mechanisms for annual monitoring and evaluation of operational plans, ensure that policies are consistently implemented and regularly reviewed for effectiveness and impact on performance, and expand the scope of benchmarking to cover all core activities. The University also should ensure that their range of research and scholarly activities positively impact student learning and develop a systematic approach to analyse and utilise stakeholder feedback on community engagement for further continuous improvement.
